

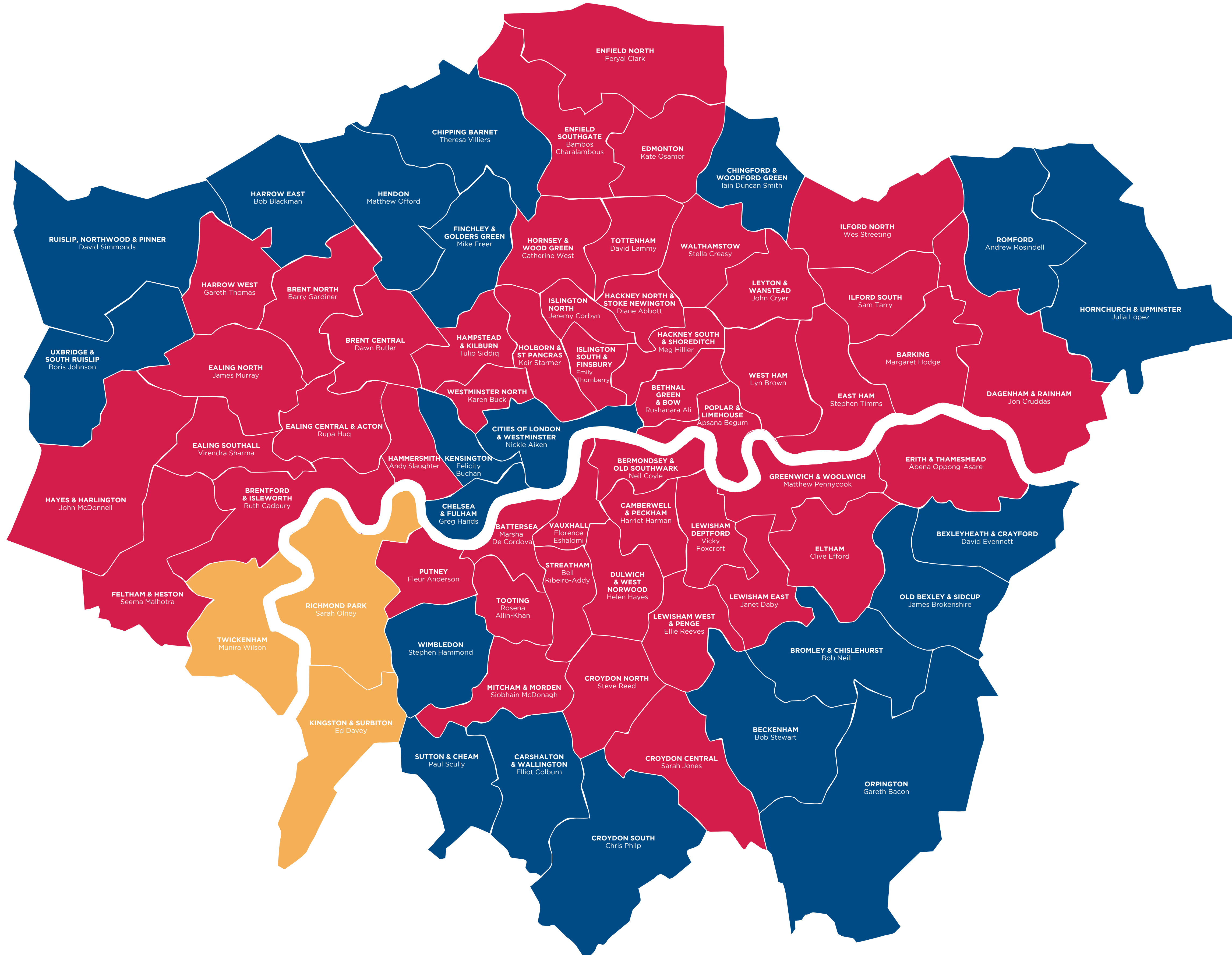
LONDON'S POLITICAL MAP 2021

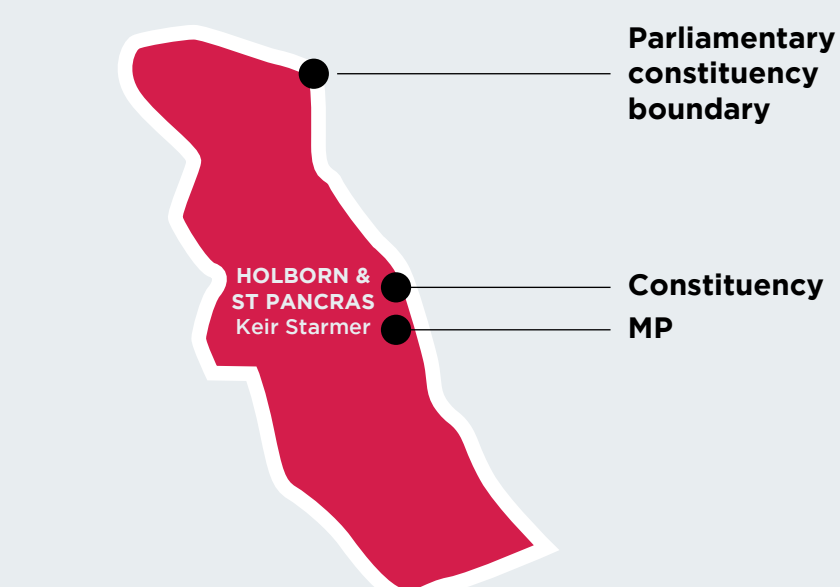

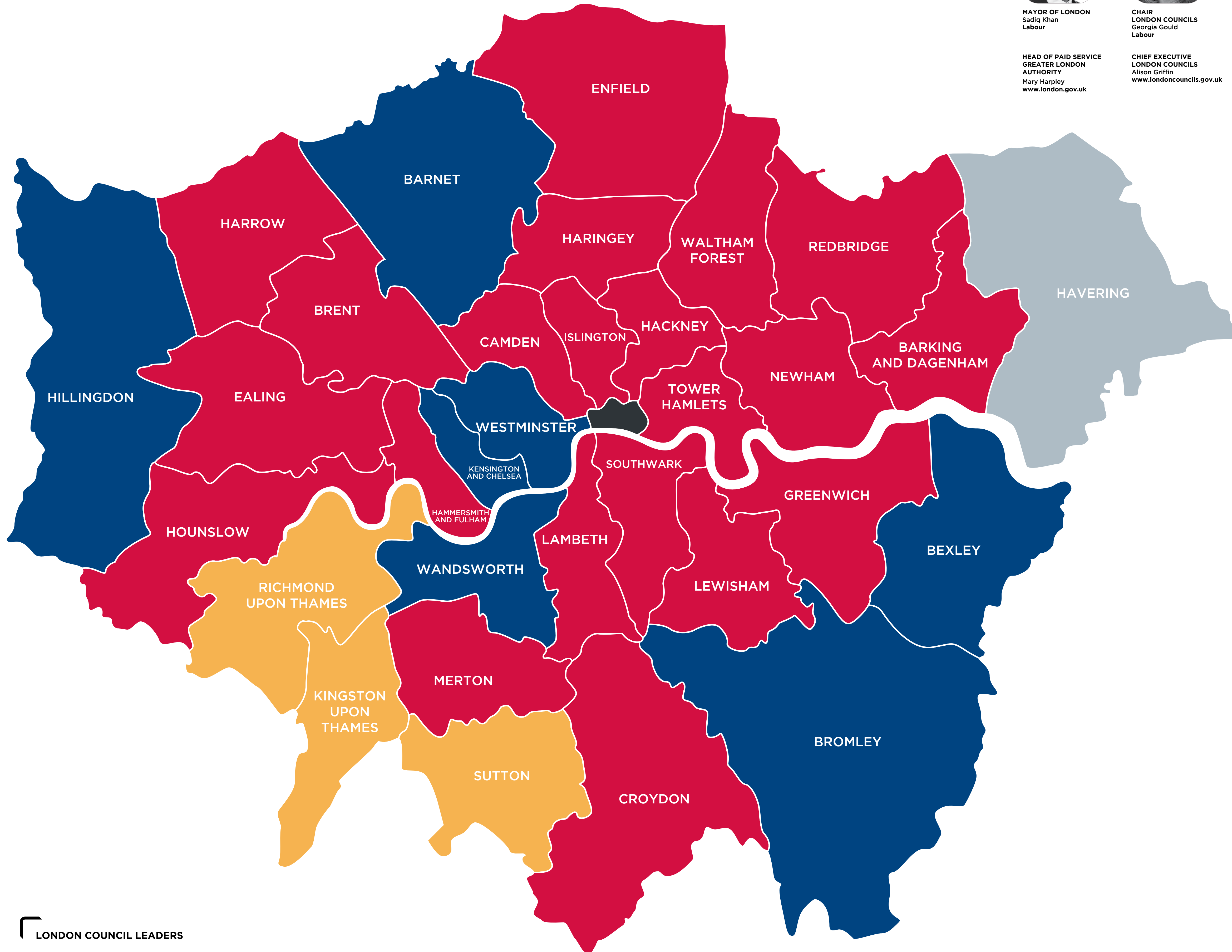
LONDON'S POLITICAL MAP 2021

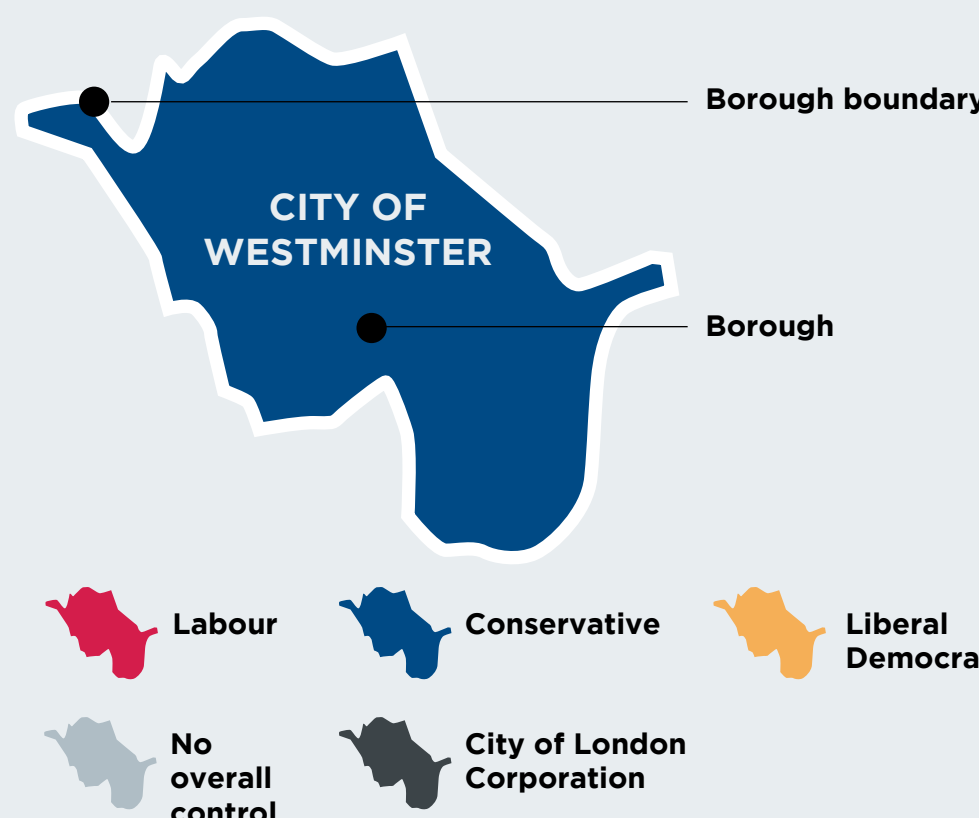
